

Primary Evangelism Scripture

- **Matthew 28: 19-20** says:
- Go ye, therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: 20 Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, *even* unto the end of the world. Amen.

Romans 10: 9-10

- 9 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.
- 10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness, and with the mouth, confession is made unto salvation.

Main evangelism definition

- **Evangelism** is sharing the good news of Jesus Christ; telling others about the salvation of Jesus Christ
- **Accountability** responsibility requirement obligation (all Christian are called to evangelize)

Evangelism Objectives

- Share the good news of the Gospel tell people about the hope and salvation of Jesus Christ
- Highlights the rewards of Heaven and the consequences of Hell
- Support Church evangelistic efforts
- Share written Christian education materials and other evangelistic resources
- Highlights the importance of Prayer and the Scripture

How to be effective in sharing the good news

- Be filled with the Holy Spirit.
- Be prepared to do a spiritual battle with the forces of evil.
- Be aware of your spiritual heritage; know that you are a child of God
- Hunger and thirst for righteousness
- Confess all sin and unrighteousness
- Willingly surrender the control of your life to Christ
- Believe in God; have faith that good will triumph over evil.

Why Jesus was an effective evangelist

- Jesus honored the teachings of the scripture
- Jesus humbled himself; he was baptized by John the Baptist
- Jesus prayed to the Father
- Jesus lived a holy, sinless life
- The words of Jesus did not contradict his actions and behavior
- Jesus loved nonbelievers
- The compassion of Jesus was evident when he placed his hands on the runny soars of the leper
- Jesus Christ had no identity crisis; He knew he was the Son of God
